Annual CCR Fugitive Dust Control Report

On June 21, 2022, Corporate Environmental along with the certifying Professional Engineer, conducted a site walkdown and review of the CCR Fugitive Dust Plan (Plan). This annual evaluation was conducted in accordance with 40 C.F.R. §257.80(c) and Section 3.2 of the Plan. Corporate Environmental conducted follow up inspections on October 26 and December 6, 2022.

Actions Taken to Control CCR

The methods used to control CCR fugitive dust at SGS are documented within the Plan. During the annual review, existing areas of control and their control measures were identified as not having been included in the existing Plan. In response to these findings, Seminole prepared and posted a revised Plan to the public facing website.

During the year, any incident involving dusting of CCR was recorded in an incident report as required by the Plan. Upon notification of any dusting of CCR, SGS staff took immediate actions to remove that equipment from service and address any malfunctions.

Citizen Complaints

No citizen complaints regarding CCR fugitive dust at SGS were received during the review period.

Summary

Seminole performs regular evaluations of the effectiveness of the Plan and updates the plan as needed. Based on these evaluations a revised plan was developed and posted to the public website in 2022. Follow up inspections did not identify any need for additional changes to the current Plan.
